


OBJECTIVES

- 1.To familiarise participants with the principles of socially responsible investing (SRI) and its importance in the context of micro, small and medium-sized enterprises (MSMEs).
- 2. Examine the key elements of SRI, including environmental, social, and governance (ESG) criteria, and how they can be applied to assess MSME sustainability practices.
- 3. Promote critical thinking and decision-making skills by engaging participants with case studies and real-life scenarios related to SRI in MSMEs.
- 4. Provide participants with a comprehensive understanding of fundamental financial planning concepts, including budgeting and cash flow management, working capital management, forecasting and financial projections, risk and debt management and profitability analysis

- Participants will be able to identify the principles of financial planning and create tailor-made financial plans for the specific needs of MSMEs.
- Participants will be able to evaluate different investment strategies and financing options and make informed decisions that contribute to the growth and development of MSMEs.

- Participants will be able to demonstrate the importance of integrating ESG factors into financial decisions, leading to sustainable financial planning that is consistent with ESG objectives.
